

New Door Access System



Here are a couple of reminders:

DOES EVERYONE IN THE FUMC CONGREGATION HAVE TO GET A FOB OR CARD?

NO. You only need to get a fob or card if you need to access the church building through the Front Door or Alley Door. If you use the keypads now, you will need to get a fob or card. **Sunday morning access through the Sanctuary doors does not require a fob or card.**

HOW DO I GET MY FOB OR CARD?

If you want to get a fob or a card, complete the card that was enclosed in the letter. Either mail it to the church, drop it in the collection plate on Sundays, or drop it off at the table that will be set up during Fellowship Time between services. Your fob or card can be picked up during Fellowship Time on **Sunday's July 25th and August 1st**, or at the church office the week of **July 26th between 9:00 a.m. and 12 noon, Monday through Thursday.**

Disciple Fast Track Coming in the Fall


Greetings, Friends and Fellow Bible Students!

Kim and I are planning a Disciple Fast Track Bible Study for the fall that will begin on Monday evening, August 30, 2021, 6 PM Mountain Time (US) and will be a hybrid class: In-person for those in the local area AND with Zoom to enable persons to participate who are part of the larger, virtual community we have established with the "help" of the COVID-19 pandemic.


The first session on August 30th will be an orientation to the approach of Disciple Fast Track and will last about an hour. We will then meet for 12 consecutive Mondays beginning Sept. 6th ("Labor Day" in the US) at 6 PM Mountain Time (US); our sessions will last for 90 minutes. This is planned so that we will conclude the fall segment of our Bible Study on Monday, Nov. 22, 2021, just prior to the Thanksgiving Holiday in the US. We will determine the schedule for the winter/spring 2022 segment as the fall segment comes to a close.

As it turns out, Disciple Bible Study offers the ideal study of Paul through the New Testament segments of two of its courses: (1) "Into the Word, Into the World", also known as "Disciple II" and (2) "Remember Who You Are", also known as "Disciple III". The fall 2021 segment, beginning August 30th, will focus on Paul's journeys as told in Luke's Acts of the Apostles, and the winter/spring 2022 segment will focus on Paul's letters to the Christian communities whose stories are (partially) told in Acts.


